## Common challenges schools face

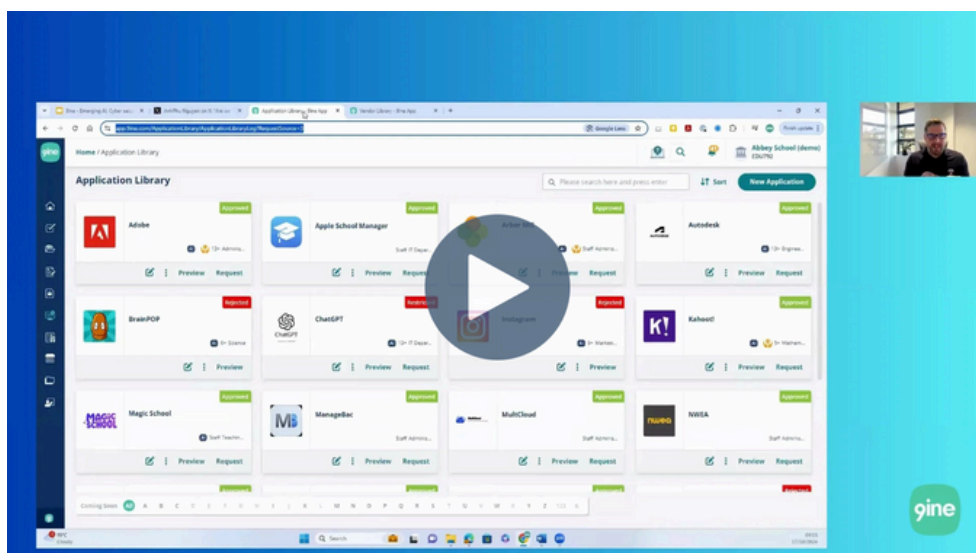
- Difficulty articulating why an application has been accepted or rejected to your staff.

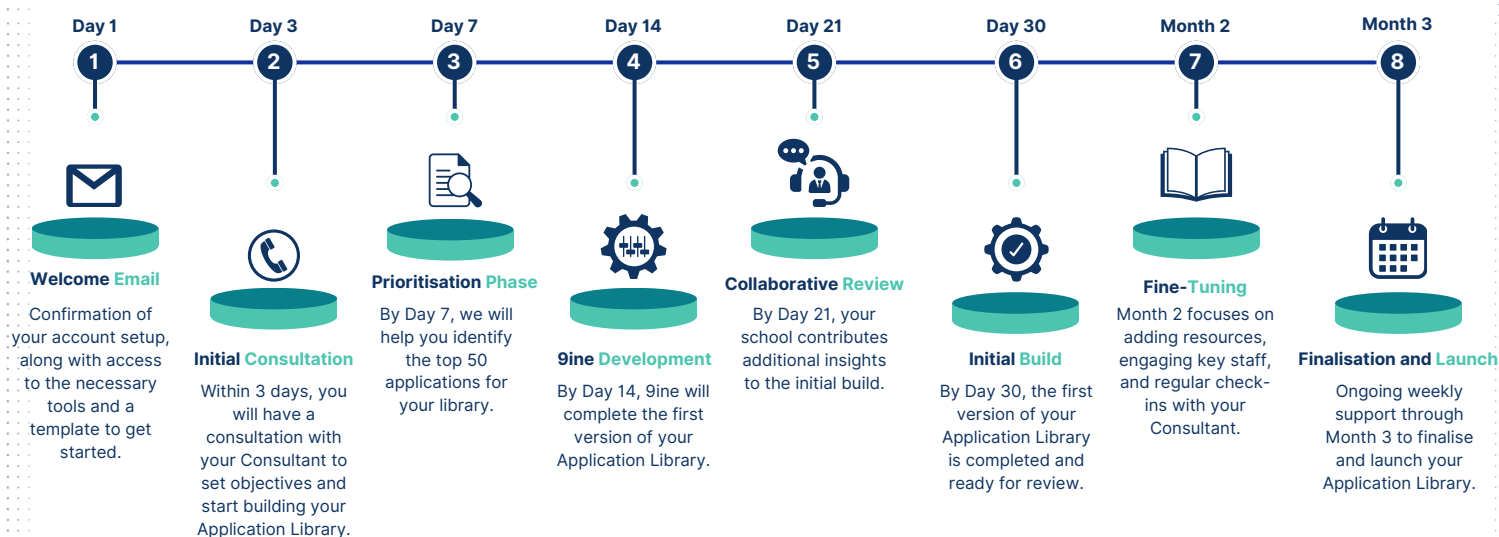
